

WARSAW (PL) may 5–6, 2017 “European Days” Final stage of the International Competition

On May 5th and 6th, 2017, dates that recall the May 9th 1950 when the Minister Robert Schuman presented a proposal to create an organized and cohesive Europe to maintain peace on the continent, in Warsaw there are the traditional "European Days" promoted by the Robert Schuman Foundation in Warsaw, also partner of the "Giovani Idee" Association in the International Competition on the theme "Working for Europe: Right to the future."

Within these days, Friday, on May 5th it will take place the final of the International Competition "Working for Europe: Right to the Future" in the prestigious Palace of the Academy of Sciences, downtown.

At the event were invited, with their representatives, all 35 schools (29 from Italy and 6 from other European Countries) who have presented their work to the competition.
